Academic Policies

- 0.5 general elective course
- Available to all current UofGH students
- Course Structure
 - Prior to departure, classes in-person (first or second week in May)
 - Pre-departure orientation (mandatory, in-person)
 - Study tour
 - Coursework



Eligibility & Admission Criteria

Academic suitability

- ✓ Applicants must meet the admission requirements and be in good academic standing
- ✓ Instructor consent is required



- ✓ The online application will collect your personal information and ask the following questions:
 - 1. What draws you to this specific global learning opportunity? Briefly explain how it connects to your academic interests (across any discipline), intellectual curiosities, or career plans.
 - 2. What do you hope to gain from this opportunity? Name one or two specific things you want out of this experience (e.g., a skill to practice or an issue to explore) and how this tour will help you do that.
 - 3. What challenges do you expect while on the tour (culture, language, personal)? Tell us about a time you adapted to something new and how that experience will guide you on this trip.
 - 4. What strengths will you bring to the group? Share any relevant experience or preparation (academic, personal, or interpersonal) and how it will help you contribute to a supportive, academically engaged cohort.

Day #5: Athens | Delphi

Travel to Delphi with an expert local guide to explore this ancient sanctuary. Visit the Temple of Apollo and the Delphi Archaeological Museum and Delphi Museum to uncover Greece's sacred past.

Day #6: Delphi | Thermopylae | Meteora

Journey north to Thermopylae to visit the famed battle site and snap a Spartan-style photo. Continue to otherworldly Meteora to tour a cliff-top monastery with an expert local guide and marvel at the town "suspended in the middle of the sky."

Day #7: Meteora | Vergina | Veria | Thessaloniki

Journey east from Meteora to Vergina and Veria for a guided sightseeing that reveals Macedonia's royal past. Visit the archaeological site of Aigai to stand among the ancient tombs and artifacts that tell the story of Alexander's lineage before arriving in vibrant Thessaloniki.

Day #8: Thessaloniki

Explore vibrant Thessaloniki on a guided tour with an expert local guide who brings the city's layered history to life. Visit the Roman Agora to learn about ancient civic life, the White Tower to trace its maritime and Ottoman past, and the Jewish Museum to discover Thessaloniki's Jewish heritage.

NEXT STEPS

Step 1

- Submit Online Application (by Sept 30 for priority review, or by Oct. 20 for final deadline)
 - ✓ Apply at www.guelphhumber.ca/current-students/global-learning

Step 2

- Pay \$199 deposit to EF Tours on the same day you submit your online application
 - ✓ Secure your spot on the EF tours by Sept. 30 to lock in the price. Program price will increase Oct. 1
 - ✓ <u>NOTE</u>: your application *will not be considered complete* without the deposit

Step 3

- Wait for an email regarding your application status (after Oct. 30)
