What courses do I need to complete in order to graduate?

Students typically receive 10.0 transfer credits when entering the SSWS transfer program. The remaining 10.0 credits of the degree are outlined on the second page of this document. Students must complete 9.5 core credits and 0.5 general elective credit to be eligible to graduate. If you have received more than 10.0 credits, you are encouraged to consult with your Academic Advisor. Please refer to your Transfer Credit Assessment to confirm the credits form which you are exempt.

May I take a SSWS course as an elective?

No. Electives are designed to give students breadth and depth in their studies.

May I take some of my courses on campus rather than online?

Potentially. You can request to take a course via a different delivery method. See your Academic Advisor for more information and assistance with planning and sequencing your courses.

Am I required to complete a field placement?

No. CSS students are granted transfer credit for all field placement courses in the program.

May I declare a specialization?

Transfer students admitted under an articulation agreement (block credit) are not eligible for a specialization.
