## 2023-24 Tuition for Out-of-Province First-Year Students

Domestic tuition rates for provincially regulated programs in Ontario were reduced by 10 per cent in 2019, and tuition for Ontario students has remained frozen.

This year, post-secondary institutions across Ontario had the opportunity to adjust tuition rates in select program areas to align with market rates and address inequities where existing rates are significantly below the sector average for comparable programs.

The Government of Ontario introduced flexibility to increase tuition fees for domestic out-ofprovince students by up to 5 per cent in all other degree programs. In order to continue to provide a high-quality academic experience for our students, the University is increasing tuition for out-ofprovince by 5 per cent for 2023/24. The 2023-24 tuition rates below become effective in fall 2023 for first-year students. These amounts reflect **tuition only** for two semesters.
