

JOHN HOLLAND ANNUAL EXCELLENCE IN JUSTICE AWARD

This annual award has been established to honour John Holland, who was a Senior Program Specialist and is now a retired member of the Department of Homeland Security United States, Federal Law Enforcement Training Centre. He has earned 50 years of Law Enforcement experience. For a number of years Mr. Holland has kindly volunteered his time to come and teach the Justice Studies students at the University of Guelph-Humber.

The award will be presented during the annual University of Guelph-Humber Awards Banquet in March.

Selection Process:

The award recipient will be decided on by the Awards Committee.

Eligibility:

- Nominee must be enrolled in the Honours Bachelor of Applied Science in Justice Studies program
- Nominee must have a minimum cumulative average of 75%
- Nominee must demonstrate a commitment to ethical behaviour in all curriculum assignments, practice volunteerism within the program, value diversity and respect fellow students and faculty members

Nomination Package Must Include:

1. A Nomination Form
2. A letter of nomination that outline's the nominee's contribution(s) to the Honours Bachelor of Applied Science in Justice Studies program
3. A letter of support from at least one of the following: an individual student, organization member, faculty, or staff
4. Nominations may also include any additional information or documentation illustrative of nominee's suitability (i.e. awards, certificates, news articles, etc.)

Deadline Date:

Nomination packages and supporting documentation must be received in the Student Financial Services office (GH112) by October 7.
