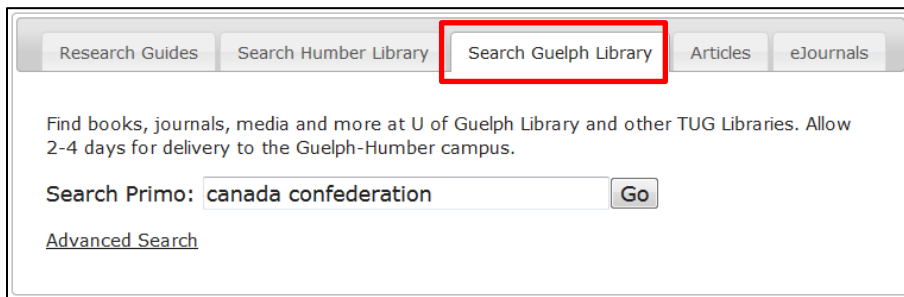


Finding eBooks at Guelph

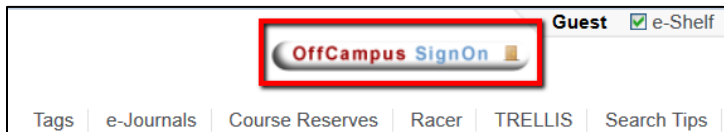
Students and faculty at the University of Guelph-Humber have access to more than 350,000 ebooks through the University of Guelph library. This guide shows you how to locate and access ebooks online.

1. On the [UofGH Library homepage](#), select the **Search Guelph Library** tab. Enter your keywords in the Search Primo box. Click **Go**.

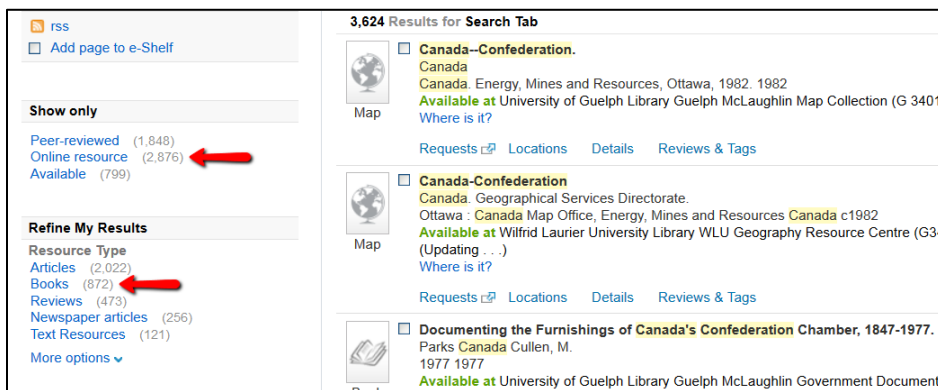


Primo search results include all formats: books, ebooks, journal articles, maps, films and more.

2. You must be logged in to access ebooks. Click the button labeled **Off Campus Sign On** to login.



3. Limit your search results to ebooks by clicking **Books** and **Online Resource** in the left hand menu.
