



Humber VPN and Multi-factor authentication setup


In order to access Humber services remotely, you will need to set up and install Humber's VPN service using multi-factor authentication (this is a one-time setup). Please follow the below steps to get started.




1 Go to <https://myremoteaccess.humber.ca> and type in your Guelph-Humber email address and then enter your GryphMail credentials




2 Select **"I want to set up a different method"** to set up using your **"Phone"** as your verification method. (If you prefer to use the app-based authentication, you can download the Microsoft Authenticator app and set it up for authentication.)




3 Enter your phone number and select the **"Text me a code"** method and then verify with the 6-digit code that was sent to your mobile number.



4 This will complete the Multi-factor authentication setup.

5 After logging into the “my remote access Humber portal”, you can now install “Big-IP Edge Client” for Mac or Windows operating systems to be able to access Humber services remotely.
