Study Abroad History

- ✓ Our first study tour was to London in 2010
- ✓ So far, we have conducted a total of **97** study tours
- ✓ Students have traveled to **38** different countries
- ✓ Over 1,000 students have participated

STUDY ABROAD

- 0.5 general elective course
- Available to all current UofGH students
- Course Components
 - Prior to departure, classes in-person or online depending on the course director)
 - Pre-departure orientation – mandatory, in-person
 - Study tour (~10 days)
 - Coursework
 - 60% final paper (final research project or paper)
 - 40% other (journals, assignments, participation, etc.)



Eligibility & Admission Criteria

- **Academic suitability**
 - ✓ Applicants must meet the admission requirements and be in good academic standing
 - ✓ Instructor consent is required
- **Completed and signed application – due November 9**
 - ✓ The online application will collect your personal information and also ask for a personal statement (750 words maximum) answering the following questions:
 - a) Why are you interested in going on a UofGH Study Tour? How does this course benefit your personal goals?
 - b) How is your choice of study tour participation academically relevant and/or related to your professional development/goals?
 - c) Travelling abroad can be challenging and can push you outside of your comfort zone. Tell us about your experience and/or skills that will help ensure your well-being while abroad.
- **First non-refundable deposit of \$200**

For your application to be considered complete, you must submit:

First non-refundable deposit of \$200 on WebAdvisor by November 16



How much does it cost?

- The cost of all courses will be **\$2,500 CDN** plus tuition for all courses with the exception of **Ecuador and Galapagos Islands, New Zealand, and Singapore & Bali** which will cost **\$3,000**
- You don't have to pay all at once
- You can pay the non-tuition portion in **3 instalments** – November, January and March
- Tuition for the course will be due in **May**
- Deposits are non-refundable except where the course is cancelled or you are not admitted into the course



What does the \$2,500/\$3,000 cover?

- Flight
- Accommodations
- Excursions - that complement the academic component of the trip
 - ✓ Transfer to and from scheduled activities
 - ✓ Entry fees (museums, parks, etc.)
- Some meals
 - ✓ Breakfast, if possible




Payment will be collected in **3 instalments** as follows...

Tuition for the course will be due in May. Deposits are generally non-refundable, except where the course is cancelled or you are not admitted into the course.

Step 1

- Submit online application by **Thursday, November 9**

Step 2

- Receive an email indicating that a \$200 charge has been applied to your WebAdvisor account

Step 3

- Pay first deposit by **Thursday, November 16**

Study Abroad Travel Grant

- Multiple awards of **\$2,500** for students registered in AHSS*3500 International Field Study in the summer semester with a minimum 70% cumulative average
- No separate application required. **All those who apply for and get selected for the UofGH Study Abroad course are automatically considered for the travel grant**
- The awards will be selected but not granted until the Study Abroad participation
- Selection will be based on academic achievement, demonstrated relevance of the travel to the student's academic studies, and benefit to the applicant
