

MICHAEL NIGHTINGALE COMMUNITY ENRICHMENT AWARD

This annual award has been established to honour Michael Nightingale, who served as the first Vice Provost and Chief Academic Officer at the University of Guelph-Humber from 2001 to 2005. Throughout his tenure, Michael's vision and dedication were critical in shaping both the academic and co-curricular environments at the University of Guelph-Humber.

Selection Process:

The award recipient will be decided on by the Awards Committee.

Eligibility:

- Nominee must be graduating in June 2021 or graduated in November 2020
- Nominee must have made the most significant contribution to the University of Guelph-Humber community, beyond their own program of study
- Nominee must have commitment to enriching the student experience at the University which includes, but is not limited to:
 - o Encouraging increased student involvement in campus life and learning
 - o A commitment to strengthening the sense of community within the University of Guelph-Humber and Humber College
 - o Demonstrating innovation in academic or student life
 - o Encouraging student and faculty interaction
 - o Advocating on behalf of the needs, aspirations and interests of all University of Guelph-Humber students

Nomination Package Must Include:

1. A Nomination Form
2. A letter of nomination that provides evidence that the nominee has made a significant contribution to the University of Guelph-Humber and has demonstrated a commitment to enriching the student experience
3. Letters of support from at least two of the following: individual students, organization members, faculty and staff (maximum of four letters)
4. Nominations may also include any additional information or documentation illustrative of nominee's suitability (i.e. awards, certificates, news articles, etc.)

Deadline Date:

Nomination packages and supporting documentation must be received in the Student Financial Services office (GH112) by February 15.
