This annual award was established in 2013 to recognize students in the Honours Bachelor of Applied Science in Early Childhood Studies program who have demonstrated outstanding achievement at their field placement.

#### **Selection Process:**

The award recipient will be decided on by the Awards Committee.

#### **Eligibility:**

- Nominee must be registered as a full-time student in the Honours Bachelor of Applied Science in Early Childhood Studies program
- Nominee must have completed either ECS\*2040 or subsequent field placements
- Nominee must demonstrate outstanding achievement in a field placement

#### **Nomination Package Must Include:**

- 1. A Nomination Form
- 2. A one-page letter of recommendation from a field placement course instructor/site supervisor who can attest to the nominee's outstanding placement activities

#### **Deadline Date:**

Nomination packages and supporting documentation must be received in the Student Financial Services office (GH112) by February 15.
