## Admission Information:

Current University of Guelph-Humber students should be in good academic standing with a minimum of 2.0 credits of study complete. Students must meet the high school prerequisites of the program to which they intend to apply.

Students intending to transfer from the University of Guelph to the University of Guelph-Humber should have a minimum 70% cumulative average to be eligible for admission. Students must meet prerequisites of the program to which they intend to apply.

## **Transfer Credit:**

Due to the structured nature of the University of Guelph-Humber's programs, students applying for a program transfer should be aware that you may not be able to enter directly into the senior year of study without having to complete some core courses that are offered in year 1 and 2. The number of transfer credits granted is not automatic and will be assessed on an individual basis.

Students transferring from the University of Guelph are expected to submit all course syllabi with the Program Transfer application.
