- Nominee must have taken initiative beyond the scope of their role; demonstrating leadership in a team setting; enhancing the department's program or service.

Nomination Package Must Include:

- 1. A Nomination Form
- 2. A one-page letter of reference from a fellow coworker or supervisor outlining the candidate's contribution and its impact.

Deadline Date:

Nomination packages and supporting documentation must be received in the Student Financial Services office (GH112) by February 15.
